6. Prize money will be paid out between 3.30pm and 4.30pm in the industrial marquee
7. Points to be awarded: 1st 3pts, 2nd 2pts, 3rd 1pt throughout- only highest points are collated for cups
8. Cups and/or special prizes will be awarded for most points in certain classes
9. Exhibits not removed by 5pm are left at the owners risk
